Frequency of Lectures: Two lectures will be provided monthly, each held on Saturdays, from 10am to 4.30pm. This will amount to a total of 18 lectures per year. Please note, July, August & December will not feature lectures, so as participants can enjoy a nice Summer and Christmas break.

Can the course be attended online via Zoom? Yes, with the exception of certain vital practical aspects of the course, aspects which shall require compulsory in-person attendance. Such examples include; needle insertion technique, needle safety, including safe disposal of same, palpation skills, pulse diagnosis, manual handling demonstrations and more.

Lunch & Breaks: Lunch will be from 1pm to 2pm each Saturday, and there will also be two separate and additional 15 minutes breaks throughout the day, in order to keep students fresh.

Annual Course Fee: €2,500* per student, per academic year. *Flexible payment plans are available.
